

ATV guide/ info for Down East Sunrise Trail
(Trail # - MATS 206)

Mile Post 2 Trail Head, Parking Lot at Washington Junction, Hancock (no trail access to Ellsworth)

Mile Post 11 Franklin Trading Post 565-3314 groceries, fuel, also a restaurant that is serves food from 6am to 1 pm

MP 16 ¾ shared use road access to primitive camping on state land (Donnell Pond Unit)

MP 29 ½ North St Café 546-7780 (closed Tuesday) restaurant

MP 30 Wild Game Guide Services 546-7221, lodging (up to 12 people)

MP 30 ½ CH Mathews groceries 546-2601, also Englishman's B&B 1,000 feet 546-2337

MP 36 ½ Scovil's Millside Dining 483-6544 (1/2 mile via access route and short trail)

MP 37 ½ American Pie Pizza 483-2227 ¾ mile via trail

MP 37 ½ Harrington Irving 483-4694 (1 ½ mile via trail and access route) fuel and food (Subway) Bud's Power Equipment 483-2874 ATV repairs ¼ mile from Irving

MP 58 ½ Machias area motel, food , fuel (the Machias Motor Inn 255-4861 and The Inn at Shoppee Farm 255-4648 are trail accessible)

MP 62 Riverside Inn 255-4134 (food and lodging)

MP 62 ½ Archibald's One Stop 255-3827 fuel and small convenience store lots of parking (last fuel on Down East Sunrise Trail headed east)

MP 64 Route 191 Diner 259-1102 (via trail about 1000 feet)

MP 69.9 Cabin Rental 255-3676

MP 78.9 Whiting store 733-4432 food and fuel, 14 miles via trail,

MP 80 Robinson's Cottages 726-9546 via trail 1000 feet

MP 87 Parking lot End of Down East Sunrise Trail,

MP 87 a club trail continues on for several miles before becoming several miles of access routes into Pembroke, fuel and food, there is also an access route into Robbinston.

Trail note:

There are over 900 miles of ATV trails that are interconnected and accessible at the following Mile Post along the trail

MP 29 ¾ (trail # 514) length 17 miles also intersects with #504

MP 30 ¾ unnumbered trail RW Mathews fuel 2 miles, to Steuben fuel and food 13 miles (Cherryfield to Steuben very muddy and rough)

MP 32 ½ (trail #504) 30 miles to Airline Lodge and Diner where food, fuel, and lodging are available

MP 37 ½ (trail #514) length 17 miles also intersects with #504

MP 54 ½ (trail #516) can go to Grand Lake Stream (fuel) 796-5027 via this trail or back to the Airline Lodge and Diner

MP 58 ¾ (unnumbered) behind Dunkin Donuts (may have to use alternative access route to access this trail)

MP 70 ½ trail #101 access to primitive camping state lands- Rocky Lake Unit, Wesley (fuel) Grand Lake Stream

MP 78.9 unnumbered, S to Whiting 14 miles (fuel), N to Alexander (fuel 27 miles) Woodland and Princeton
